

Main Street Theater COVID-19 Protocols – Public Audience

Updated April 14, 2021

Based on the recommendation of the CDC, Main Street Theater will be re-opening this summer with the following practices in place.

What to expect when you arrive at the theater:

- Due to limited seating, advance purchasing of tickets is highly recommended.
- Guests will be required to wear a face mask while in the theater, the lobby, the courtyard and on all MATCH property. If a patron does not have a mask, Main Street Theater will provide one free of charge.
- All guests will be asked to disinfect their hands with sanitizer that will be provided at the door.
- Seating will be spread out in the theater at a capacity of 30% for social distancing.
- HVAC systems at MATCH have been upgraded with germicidal UV light purification systems. These systems use photohydroionization technology which is the same technology that is been used in the medical industry to destroy airborne micro-organisms (germs, viruses, and bacteria).
- The theater will be cleaned (including all seats) between each performance.

What to expect inside the lobby:

- Hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout the lobby areas and merchandise areas.
- The merchandise area will be open immediately after the performance with attendants available to assist in retrieving items (patrons will not be allowed to touch any items until they have been purchased).
- All payment devices will be sanitized between purchases.

What to expect after the performance:

- Immediately following the performance, there will be a short question and answer session with the actors (who will remain on stage). All patrons will be asked to remain in their seats and will be dismissed one row at a time.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available at exits.
- The merchandise area will be open following the performance with the same operating procedures as above.
- There will not be an autograph line for this production.
