Main Street Theater COVID-19 Protocols

Updated August 10, 2021

Based on the recommendation of the CDC, Main Street Theater has re-opened with the following practices in place.

What to expect when you arrive at the theater:

- Guests will be required to wear a face mask while in the theater, the lobby, the courtyard and on all MATCH property. If a patron does not have a mask, Main Street Theater will provide one free of charge.
- HVAC systems at MATCH have been upgraded with germicidal UV light purification systems. These systems use photohydroionization technology which is the same technology that is been used in the medical industry to destroy airborne micro-organisms (germs, viruses, and bacteria).
- The theater will be cleaned (including all seats) between each performance.

What to expect inside the lobby:

• Hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout the lobby.

What to expect after the performance:

- Immediately following the performance, there will be a short question and answer session with the actors (who will remain on stage). All patrons will be asked to remain in their seats and will be dismissed one row at a time.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available at exits.
- The courtyard is not available for snacks or lunches at this time. We recommend Discovery Green as an alternate option.

To help prevent the spread of COVID-19 and reduce the potential risk of exposure, all staff and students should not attend the field trip if they have any of the following -

- Cough, congestion or runny nose
- Chills
- Diarrhea
- Headache
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Muscle pain or fatigue
- Sore throat
- Nausea or vomiting
- Loss of taste or smell
- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to
- 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
- Known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have
